Will you come within 30 minutes and assess the patient and complete the Inpatient Sepsis Orders? If the patient does not improve, when should I call you again? Are you satisfied with the response? If not - Say so "I am concerned" "Help me understand" "I am requesting that you come in and assess the patient" "What is the plan?" Before you end the call, repeat all orders back to the prescriber!
