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
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

Why you need to partner with the family

- The family notices when they see something they DO NOT EXPECT to see
- The family knows the baseline for their family member
- So, please INVITE FAMILY FEEDBACK (don't just hope they'll say something)
- Act on it

A WALK IN GWEN'S SHOES

GWEN

Gwen was born in Stratford, England in 1922.

She always loved entertaining.



THE SARGENT

She was stationed in London, England and Scotland during the war.

She taught communications and Morse Code.



THE ENTERTAINER

She became the female lead on a Canadian variety show for 11 years.

She also frequently appeared at the Stratford Festival and in Charlottetown's Anne of Green Gables.



THE SENIOR

She continued performing into her late 80's.

She lived alone in an apartment at the Performing Arts Lodge until the age of 89.

She described herself as a "tough old bird".



A MOVE TO LONG TERM CARE

After a decline in cognitive functioning and 3 falls in six weeks, her hospital physician insisted on Long Term Care.

CANYOU HELP ME, PLEASE!

WHAT'S GOING ON?

- "It's to be expected of a person her age."
- "It's for her own safety."
- "Calling out all the time has increased and it can be really annoying."
- We are giving her something to calm her down.

POLYPHARMACY

The use of multiple medications and/or the administration of more medications than are clinically indicated, representing unnecessary drug use.

A MEDICATION REVIEW

A quarterly practice of reviewing patient medications including a once yearly interdisciplinary review.

Objectives:

- Promoting healthier patient outcomes and better resident-focused care
- Improving and optimizing drug therapy for residents of Long Term care homes
- Promoting interdisciplinary collaboration in patient care

EXTERNAL CONSULTANT REPORT

- The anti-depressants are likely to be having a role in her destabilization
- Risperdal is excessive at the moment
- The Statex is not necessary
- Test for possible urinary tract infection

DEPRESCRIBING

Tapering or stopping medications that may be causing harm or are no longer providing benefit as well as monitoring for adverse drug withdrawal reactions in elderly patients.

EXTERNAL CONSULTANT: RECOMMENDATIONS

- Stop Statex
- Reduce Risperdal
- Reduce Cipralex
- Reduce Trazodone
- Reduce Oxazepam
- Slowly eliminate
 Seroquel and
 Benzodiazepines
